What's New?

The Inpatient Rehabilitation Unit at JNMC has added three support groups to assist our patients and families. The post-brain tumor, stroke, and amputation groups are held in the rehab dining room the second Thursday of every month at 2 p.m., 3 p.m., and 4 p.m., respectively.

 How often our patients receive a minimum of three hours of therapy per day, six days per week.

Average Length of Stay: 11.3 days National Average: 12.7 days

This describes the average number of days an individual patient spent in our inpatient rehabilitation unit.

Discharged to Community: 79.7% National Average: 77.8%

This reflects the number of patients who are able to live in the community after discharge from our program. Additionally, 13% were discharged to an acute setting and 6.5% required long-term placement.
