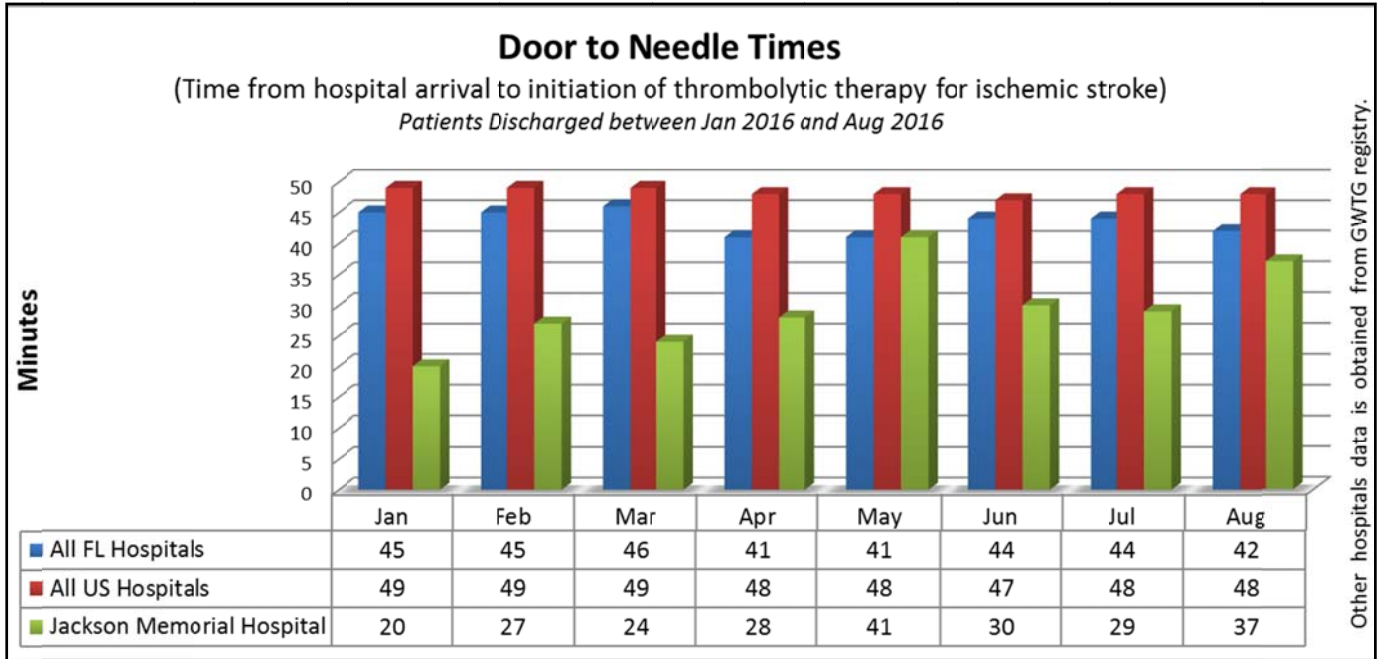


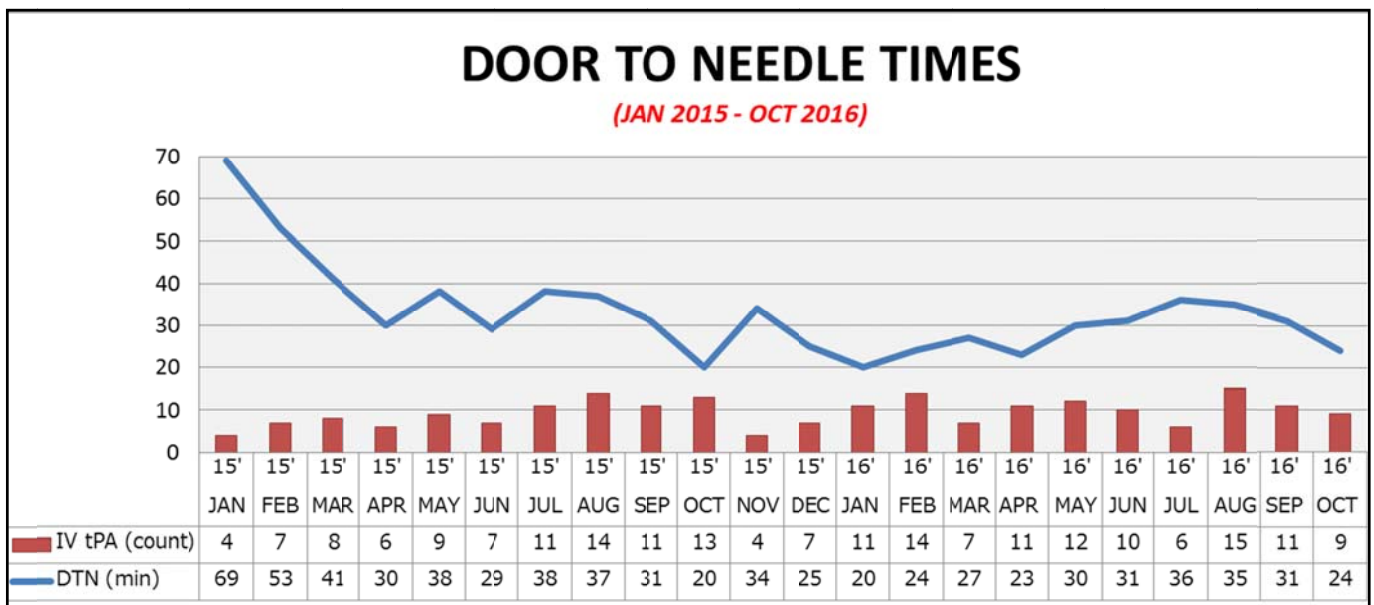
- Confirmed Stroke/TIA discharges from Jackson Memorial Hospital are approx. **800/year**.

All Stroke + Transient Ischemic Attack	192	196	200	195
• Ischemic Stroke	66%	68%	68%	63%
• Intracerebral Hemorrhage	19%	18%	16%	14%

• Transient Ischemic Attack	6%	6%	10%	11%

- Faster time to treatment than most hospitals in US.

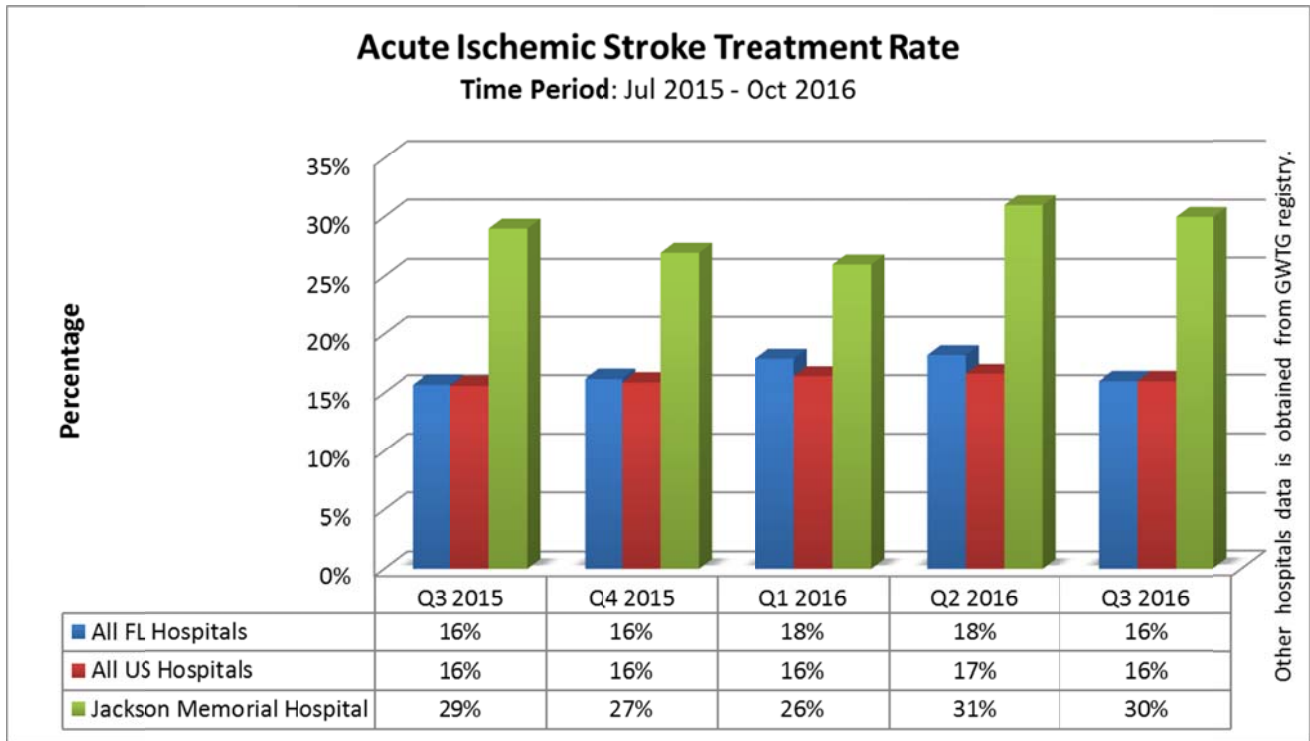


*DTN TIMES ACCORDING TO DISCHARGE DATE

- Treat more patients with thrombolytic and endovascular approaches than most hospitals in US.



- Treats aneurysms by performing endovascular coiling and microsurgical clipping. Approx. 75 coilings and 30 coilings were performed in last 12 months.
