Dr. Antonio Marttos' current academic rank is Assistant Professor of Surgery/Director of Trauma Telemedicine, Ryder Trauma Center/William Lehman Injury Research Center.

Dr. Marttos completed his Medical (1993) and Surgical Residency training in Brazil in 1997. He was professor of Emergency Medicine and Trauma Surgeon at ABC Foundation Medical School in Brazil and Chief of Surgery at Santa Marina Hospital in Brazil. In 2004 he joined Jackson Memorial Hospital for Surgical Critical Care and Trauma Fellowship. At the end of his appointment, he joined the University of Miami faculty.

Dr. Marttos participated in many research studies under US Department of Defense, US Department of State, and Florida Department of Health grants., He is also involved in education and training projects such as Robot in Trauma Environment, to develop solutions to provide expert support in Trauma environments including the Resuscitation unit, the Intensive Care Unit, and the Operating room. Telemedicine capabilities in mass casualty situations with the US Army forward surgical teams as well as in exercises conducted at the hospital; Telemedicine Education and Advice for military Medicine (TEAMM). This project is an educational program that links the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine/Ryder Trauma Center with the US Air Force. The project is delivering grand rounds lectures from Ryder Trauma Center to Military Clinicians in Huberfield Air Force Base. Telementoring in the Operating Room: Use of Telemedicine in the Operating Room to help surgeons during trauma cases.

Dr. Marttos was also awarded the Florida Department of Health Outstanding Leadership for Florida Trauma Telemedicine program.
