

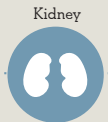

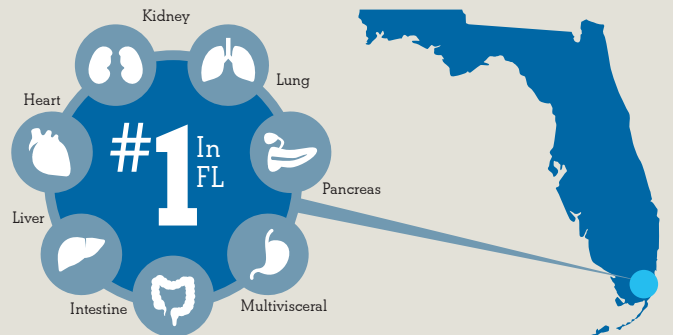

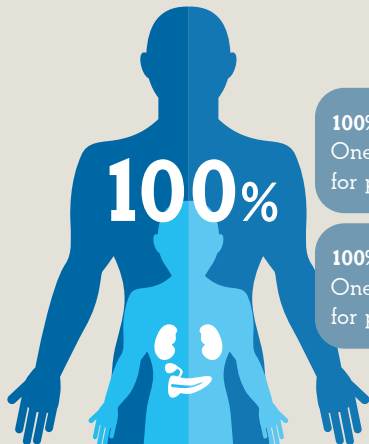
Center for Intestinal Rehabilitation

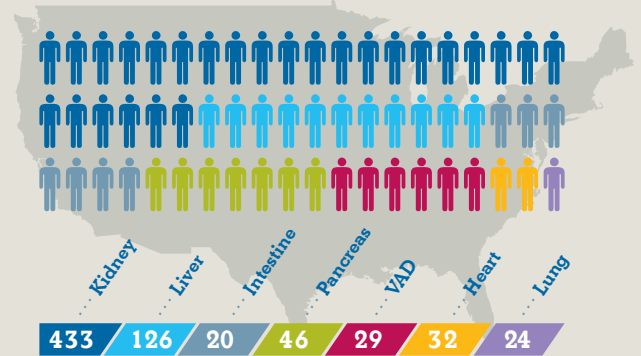
Liver Failure Team
